Child Care Aware (CCA) of Kentucky in partnership with Help Me Grow (HMG) Kentucky have created a free and simple family-engaged developmental screening and ongoing monitoring program. The system is intentionally designed to build parents and staff understanding of healthy child development, supportive services available in the community, and how both are important to improving children's outcomes and ongoing success.

By participating you will:

- Strengthen knowledge of developmental milestones and appropriate expectations by parents and staff.
- Identify each child's strengths and opportunities to provide support for challenges that may impact learning and behavior.
- Increase staff confidence when having conversations with parents about child development.
- Gain clarity on next steps for referrals to services.
- Build family engagement and parent-provider team building.
- Offer screening to be reflected in STARS rating.
- Focus on social-emotional awareness and skills.
- Have access to a variety of developmental screening and monitoring tools:

Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ-3™ and ASQ:SE-2™) online developmental screens, data collection and social-emotional resources that:

- Provide reliable source for referral to early intervention services.
- Collect data on developmental progress, identification of delays, and connection to services while tracking number of screens, referrals, outcomes, and follow-up.
- Include printable learning activities and resources to share with and support parents.

FOLLOW UP	• Schedule a follow-up meeting after using the ASO™ Online system for 2 weeks if requested
FOLLOW OP	 Schedule a follow-up meeting after using the ASQ™ Online system for 3 weeks if requested

READY TO SCREEN & MONITOR!

MEETING

START SCREENING	 Parents/guardians sign consent to participate (may be included in enrollment packets) Complete ASQ-3™ and ASQ:SE-2™ Questionnaires for each child (parents and staff) Paper questionnaire results require data entry into ASQ™ Online system Online system automatically scores questionnaires
ACT EARLY	 Share results (strengths and opportunities for growth) with parents/guardians If a questionnaire indicates a potential delay, discuss referral to early intervention service options with parents/guardians Submit quarterly Referral Report
LEARN THE SIGNS	 Share "Learn the Signs. Act Early." materials with families and staff: (Milestone Tracker App posters and flyers, Milestone Tracker App or paper copies of checklists, Milestones Matter booklets and brochures, etc.)
